## Location

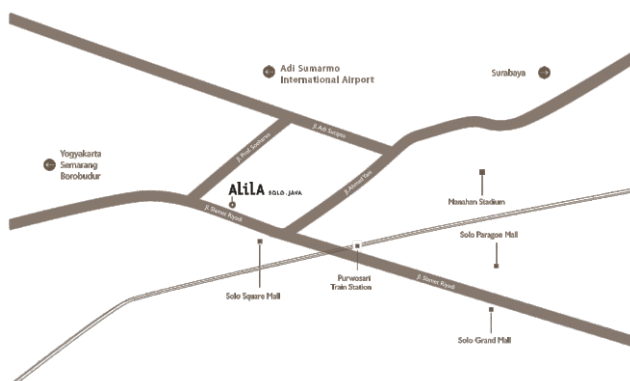
